Fill the hearts and minds of your children with love, positive limitless experience and let their personal self blossom.



One of the family members had a wielding plant and they were planning to make a hen house. I arranged for Talha to take part in measuring the iron frame and join it with the help of wielding. It helped him learn the importance of measurements and apply this to real life scenario.

Talha wanted to share his journey of learning with cousins. His teachers suggested writing letter and posting it. Talha wrote to his cousins in Sialkot. It was his first visit to post office. He waited anxiously for the letter to be received and was happy to know his cousins loved his letter.

Soon he started failing to manage his time and lacked planning; again his teacher came up with the idea of to-do list.

He started jotting down basic tasks he would want to complete during the day. This simple and inexpensive activity inculcates the habit of time management and prioritizing.
